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Article 1: Name and Legal Status

- 1.1. The name of the organization is **Doctorsact Uganda**.
- 1.2. It is a **non-political, non-religious, non-profit membership organization**, legally registered in accordance with the laws of Uganda.
- 1.3. Doctorsact Uganda is an **affiliated national chapter of Doctorsact International**.

Article 2: Vision and Mission

- 2.1. **Vision:** A healthy and empowered society with equitable access to health and development opportunities.
- 2.2. **Mission:** To improve health, education, and well-being in underserved communities through volunteer action, community development, and strategic partnerships.

Article 3: Objectives

Doctorsact Uganda shall:

- Conduct medical outreach and health awareness campaigns.
- Provide educational and capacity-building opportunities for youth and communities.
- Support community-based development projects (e.g., water, sanitation, education).
- Engage members, volunteers, and diaspora in national development.
- Collaborate with Doctorsact International and other national chapters.
- Fundraise locally and internationally to support its mission.

Article 4: Membership

- 4.1. **Eligibility:** Open to individuals who support the mission and values of the organization.
- 4.2. **Admission:** Membership is granted upon application and payment of any required dues, subject to Board approval.
- 4.3. Categories:
 - Ordinary Members: With full voting rights.
 - Honorary Members: Appointed for their contributions; no voting rights.
 - ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP
 Shall be open to all properly registered organization, voluntary social agencies in or outside the country and doctorsact volunteers engaged in line with aims and objectives of Doctorsact.
- 4.4. **Termination:** Membership may be revoked for conduct harmful to the organization, after due process.

Article 5: Rights and Duties of Members

- 5.1. Members have the right to:
 - Vote in the Annual General Meeting (AGM).
 - Elect and be elected to the Board.
 - Access information about the organization's activities and finances.
- 5.2. Members are expected to:
 - Participate in activities and meetings.
 - Promote the values of the organization.
 - Pay dues (if applicable).

Article 6: General Assembly

- 6.1. The **General Assembly (AGM)** is the highest decision-making body.
- 6.2. It shall meet at least **once per year** and is composed of all active members.
- 6.3. Responsibilities:
 - Electing the Board
 - Approving annual reports and financial statements
 - Setting strategic direction
 - Amending bylaws
- 6.4. Decisions are made by **simple majority**, unless otherwise specified.

Article 7: Board of Directors

- 7.1. The organization is governed by a **Board of Directors**, composed of **3 to 7 members** elected for a **2-year term**, can run for max of 5 years and then up for new election.
- 7.2. The Board shall:
 - Provide oversight and leadership
 - Approve budgets and policies
 - Represent the organization externally
 - Supervise staff or volunteers
- 7.3. The Board elects from among its members:

- Chairperson
- Secretary
- Treasurer

Article 8: Management and Committees

- 8.1. The Board may appoint an **Executive Director** or **Coordinator** to manage day-to-day operations.
- 8.2. Committees (e.g., Fundraising, Programs, Membership) may be formed as needed.

Article 9: Finances and Reporting

- 9.1. The organization shall maintain proper accounts and records.
- 9.2. All funds shall be used solely for organizational purposes.
- 9.3. Annual financial reports shall be presented to the AGM and, if required, audited by an independent auditor.
- 9.4. The fiscal year shall run from [1 January to 31 December].

Article 10: Relationship with Doctorsact International

- 10.1. Doctorsact Uganda shall maintain good standing with **Doctorsact International**, following its values, branding guidelines, and reporting requirements.
- 10.2. The national chapter may participate in joint campaigns, capacity-building, and global fundraising efforts.

Article 11: Amendments

- 11.1. Amendments to these bylaws require a **two-thirds (2/3) majority** at a duly convened General Assembly meeting.
- 11.2. Proposed changes must be circulated to all members at least 14 days before the vote.

Article 12: Dissolution

- 12.1. Upon dissolution, any remaining assets shall be transferred to another **non-profit organization with a similar purpose**, as determined by the General Assembly.
- 12.2. No assets may be distributed to members or private individuals.
